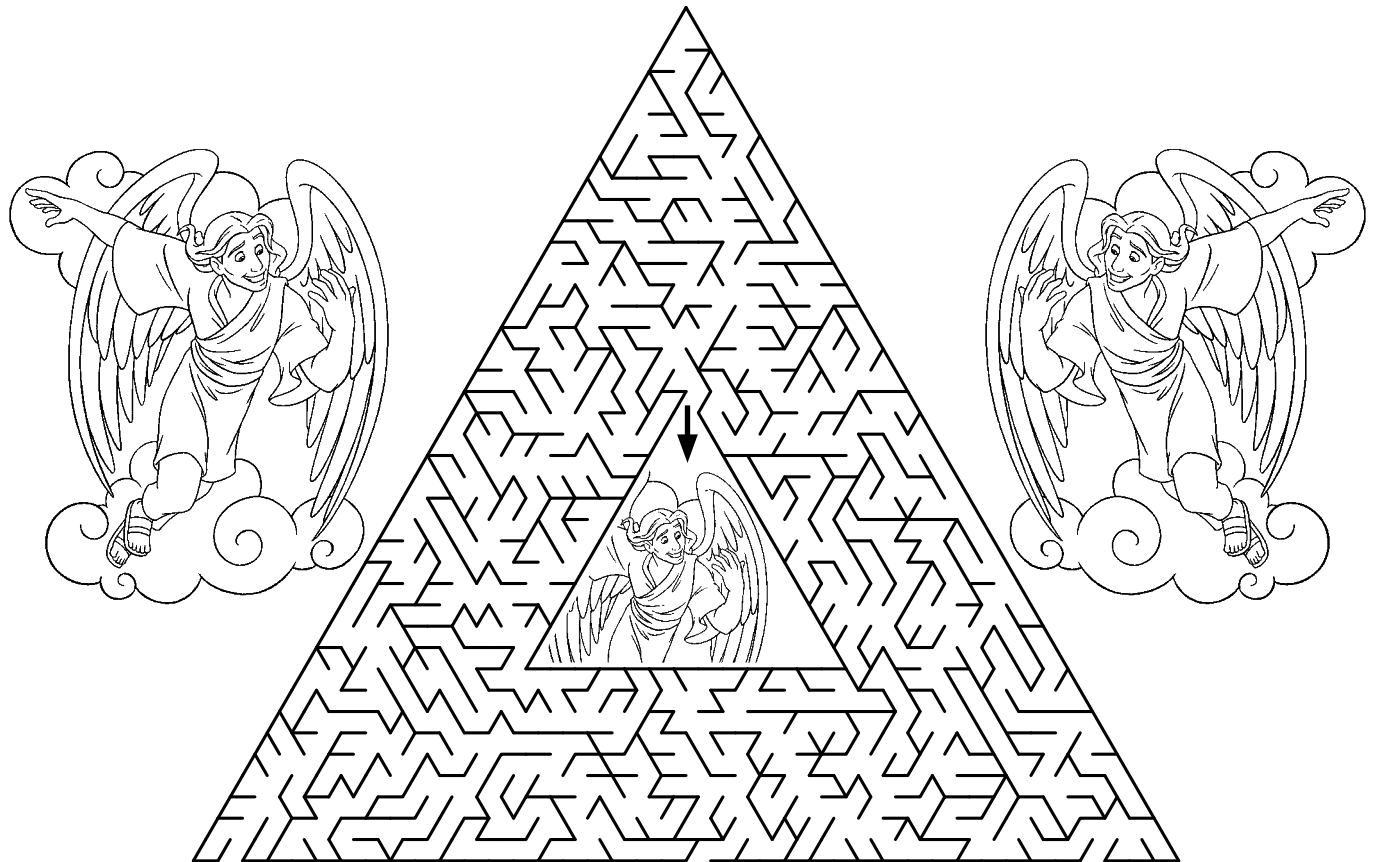

Jesus said we must **love God first**, and also **“love our neighbors as ourselves.”**

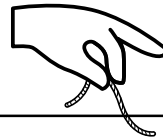
When we do this, we are obeying Jesus, which makes Him happy. It is like making Him a soft manger to sleep in!

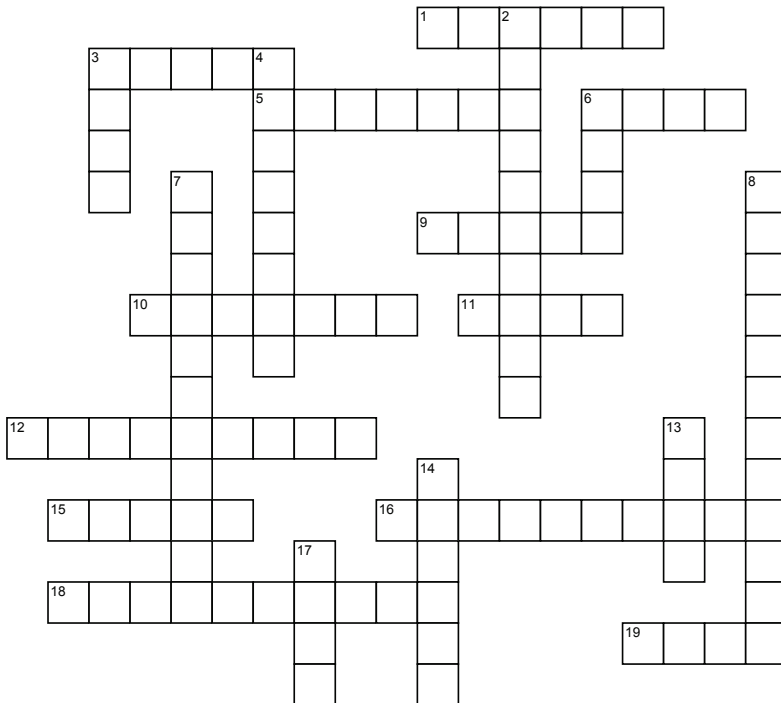


It is named for the visit of the **Archangel Gabriel** to the **Blessed Virgin Mary**, as recorded in **Luke 1: 26-38**.

# ELIJAH in Salvation History



**Elijah was a great prophet during a time when many people were worshipping false gods.** The people simply did not have faith that the One True God would fulfill His promises to their ancestors and continue



to care for them. However, Elijah trusted God, so God sent him as a messenger and used him to perform many miracles.

On Christmas Day, **PLACE** Baby Jesus in the Sacrifice Manger on top of all that nice soft "straw" that you have put there during the Advent Season!



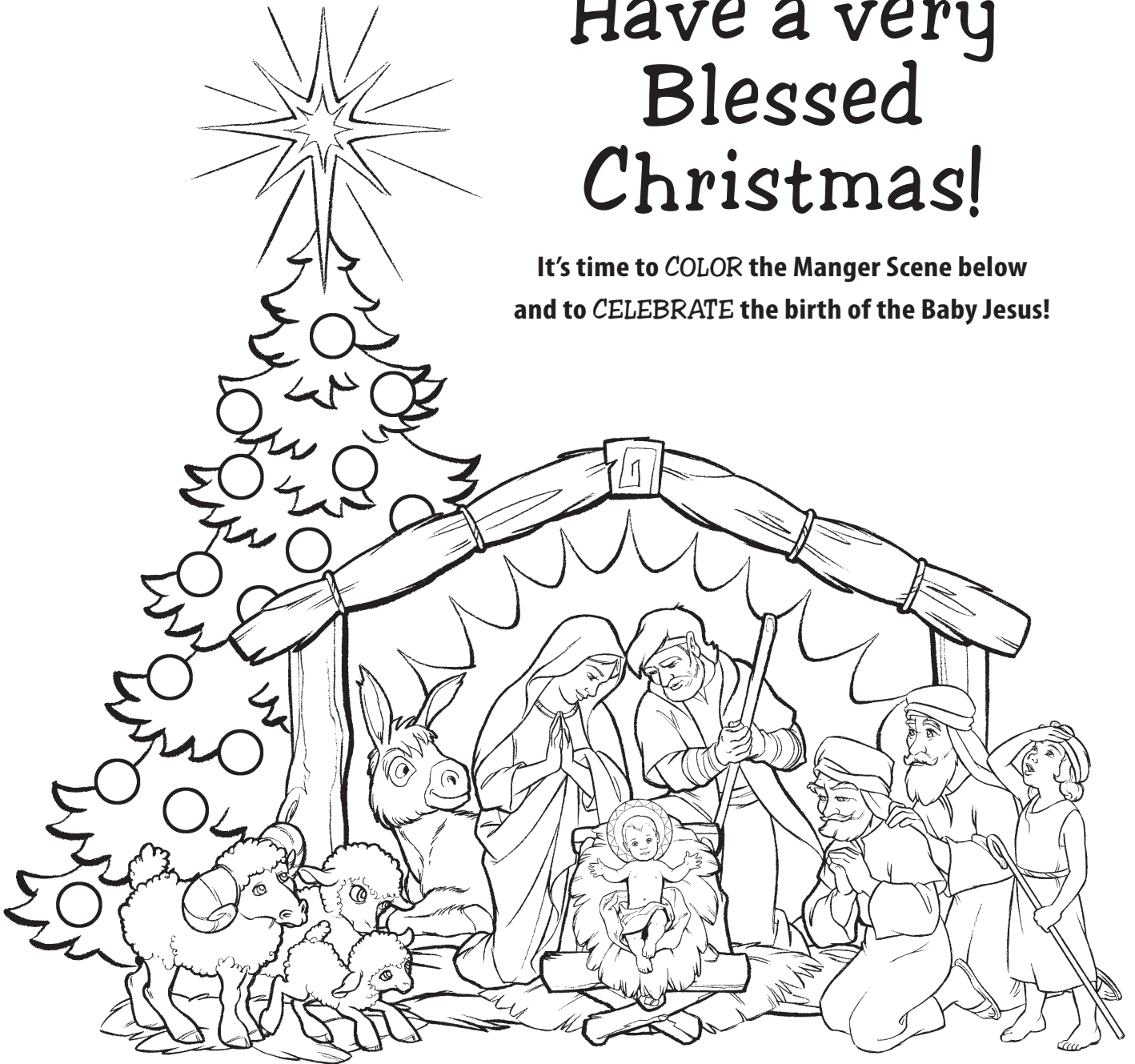
**A SUGGESTION:**
